1. True or False: The horse show calendar year begins on December 1st and ends on November 30th.
2. True or False: Four exhibitors are necessary to fill a class in order for points to count toward year end awards.
3. How many years may a horse show in the Pre-Green Division?

4. A horse that has shown for the last two years in the Adult Hunter Division changes owners. The new owner is in his/her first year of showing. Is this horse eligible to show in the Pre-Green Division with its new owner? _____. Are there any exceptions? _____.
5. True or False: Courses must be posted at least thirty (30) minutes before the class the scheduled class.
6. In which divisions does the 3" rule not apply?

7. How many exhibitors are needed to fill the South Carolina Governor's Cup Class? _____
8. True or False: A flat phase is required for the South Carolina Governor's Cup Class.
9. True or False: An exhibitor wishes to ride his/her pony in the South Carolina Governor's Cup Class. Fence heights may be lowered to 2'6" to honor this request.

10. How many exhibitors are needed to fill the Palmetto Medal Class?

11. True or False: A flat phase is necessary in Palmetto Medal Classes.

12. True or False: The Palmetto Junior Medal and Palmetto Pony Medal may be combined for lack of entries in either class with the fences being adjusted.

13. True or False: Exhibitors participating in the Walk, Trot and Canter Division may cross enter into the Short Stirrup Division.

14. What is the maximum number of jumping classes a horse can participate in one day? _____

15. True or False: A junior exhibitor enters and shows in the Children's Hunter Division. This same rider may show in the Junior Division on the same horse.

16. True or False: Ponies may participate in the Green Pony Division for two (2) years.

17. True or False: A Green Pony Division is held at the horse how. A fifteen year old junior rider participates on a small pony in the Green Pony division. This same rider is eligible to compete on the same pony in the regular small pony division.

18. True or False: There are two riders entered in the Short Stirrup Division and one rider entered in the Children's Hunter Division. These divisions can be combined by show management.

19. True or False: There is one junior rider entered in the 15-17 equitation division and four riders entered in the Adult Equitation Division. These divisions may be combined by show management.

20. True or False: Two jumping classes are held in the Regular Working Hunter Division. The under saddle class did not go. A championship and reserve championship will be awarded in this division.
